

District Parent Advisory Council representative

1. One representative to the Vancouver DPAC may be elected annually from among the voting members who are not employees or elected officials of School District No. 39 or the Ministry of Education.

2. 3. 4. The election of representatives to the DPAC, if held, must be by secret ballot. DPAC representatives will hold office for a term of one year.

If a DPAC representative resigns or ceases to hold office for any other reason, the executive may appoint an eligible member of the PAC to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term or the membership may elect an eligible member of the PAC to fill the vacancy for the remainder of the term. Such election must be by secret ballot.
